19	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
20	Section 1. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended
21	by repealing Section 1108.2, as follows:
22	SEC. 1108.2. EXEMPTION; DEEDS IN LIEU OF FORECLOSURE, ETC.
23	Any tax imposed pursuant to this ordinance shall not apply with respect to any deed, instrument,
24	or writing to a beneficiary or mortgagee, which is taken from the mortgagor, trustor or trustee, as a
25	result of or in lieu of foreclosure; provided, that such tax shall apply to the extent that the consideration

exceeds the unpaid debt, including accrued interest and cost of foreclosure. Consideration, unpaid		
debt amount and identification of grantee as beneficiary or mortgagee shall be noted on said deed,		
instrument or writing or stated in an affidavit for tax purposes.		
Section 2. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended		
by amending Section 1103, to read as follows:		
SEC. 1103. PAYMENT OF TAX.		
Any tax imposed pursuant to Section 1102 hereof shall be paid by any person who		
makes, signs or issues any document or instrument subject to the tax, or for whose use or		
benefit the same is made, signed or issued. <u>Notwithstanding the preceding sentence, no</u>		
mortgagor or trustor shall be liable for the tax where the tax is imposed pursuant to this Article with		
respect to any deed, instrument, or writing to a beneficiary or mortgagee, which is taken from the		
mortgagor, trustor, or trustee, as a result of, or in lieu of, foreclosure of a property that is occupied by		
the mortgagor or trustor as his or her principal residence. Identification of the mortgagor or trustor		
shall be noted on said deed, instrument or writing, or stated in an affidavit for tax purposes.
